Americold Service Change





Decker Electric teamed up with Square D to provide new 2000 amp service for Americold. Americold Provides cold storage for meat and other frozen products and cannot be without power for long periods of time. With this in mind, Decker planned a shutdown to minimize the time off-line. Our crews started at 7AM Saturday, and with the help of Westar, had the power cut by 8AM. Two crews worked around the clock to install the new service and had power back on by 4M on Sunday. Our crews quickly started up the new equipment and had the facility back to normal status by 8 that evening. This project took a lot of planning and work both on-site and behind the scenes. Foremen, John Ramey and John Perkins provided excellent leadership on this time-sensitive job and their crews made it all happen. Although this job was done in less than a week from start to finish, a huge amount of Decker resources were used to give our customer a great experience. All involved should be proud.

Hershey Entertainment





Decker engineered and supplied a turn-key replacement control system for an existing ride at Hershey Park in Hershey, Pennsylvania. This included replacing the existing motor/generator DC drives with AC VFD systems.

The new system includes a spare VFD that can be selected with a button on the HMI operator interface screen to replace either of the two main VFD systems without requiring a wiring or system configuration change. This system also includes a means to capture and recycle the energy produced during the ride. Before, this energy would have been burned off as heat using large restore banks. In addition, this system features a wireless pendant that allows the maintenance crew to control the operation of the ride. All of these improvements have increased the reliability and efficiency of the ride.

Thank you to Chris Martin and the rest of the crew who made this project a success.
